



Open Source Work at RaBe



- Fork of Airtime by Sourcefabric
- PHP based Web-UI with Python backend to run liquidsoap
- 100+ community members, used by countless radio stations both terrestrial and online only
- We use it to air pre-produced segments at RaBe

RaBe Liquidsoap Distribution (RaBe-LSD)

- Liquidsoap as RPM packages for Enterprise Linux distributions like CentOS
- Built to ensure that we use the same build of liquidsoap over our fleet
- Made available to the public via Open Build Service (OBS)
